## Report on the 10th Anniversary Memorial Ceremony for the victims of the Great East Japan Earthquake

On March 11, 2021, the 10th Anniversary Memorial Ceremony for the victims of the Great East Japan Earthquake was held by Sendai Buddhist Association and Tohoku Fukushi University. The event was also supported by Japan Buddhist Federation and Tokyo Buddhist Association. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, only a limited number of people were able to attend the ceremony in person. We must not forget that this is the very unfortunate reality of the disaster area today.
