**Humanitarian Relief Provided to Japan: Inundated flood July B.E. 2563 (2020)**

It was a sudden tragedy when we received the news about the heavy torrential rain in the southern and central of Japan since 4 July B.E. 2563 (2020) and its affect until to date. Please accept my deepest condolences for the loss of life and destruction caused by inundated flood.

In this regard, I have instructed Secretary-General of The WFB, Mr. Phallop Thaiarry, which was endorsed by Reverend Masamichi Kobayashi, Chairman of Humanitarian Fund of The WFB, to allocate the WFB Humanitarian Fund Relief to Japan equal to THB 1,000,000.- (approximately JPY 3,000,000.-) as immediate fund. It will be transferred to Japan Buddhist Federation for further processing as deem appropriate.

In addition, should further assistance may require, please do not hesitate to let me know. I wish that the situation will be recovered very soon. In time of crisis and distress, please know that the sorrow of Japanese Nation is shared by all member of The WFB, its sub-organizations (the World Fellowship of Buddhist Youth, and the World Buddhist University), Regional Centres and its networking organizations.

On behalf of the World Fellowship of Buddhists, may the blessing of Triple Gem and the sacred things in the world protect people of Japan from harm and make situation be back to normal.
